Policies and Procedures
Meet Obligations



On an annual basis, BAC may host two meets; the Winterfest Meet, held in January, and the Spring/Summer Challenge Meet, held in May or June. These meets serve as BAC's primary fundraisers.

Work Requirement for Each Meet

In order to support and administer our meets, each BAC family must have at least one adult family member work a minimum of three individual sessions during each meet. This requirement applies to any family with a registered swimmer during the year regardless of whether that swimmer is enrolled in the practice session coinciding with the meet. If a family member does not fulfill the three session commitment, the family will be assessed a \$60 fee for each session not worked (maximum of \$180).

Penalty for Late Payment

1. If Session Not Worked Fee is more than 20 days late, a \$20 late payment fee will be assessed.
2. If Session Not Worked Fee is unpaid for more than 45 days; Board is notified and swimmer is suspended from all membership privileges;
3. Members should contact a Board member to discuss restoring member privileges. The Board will address such situations on a case-by-case basis.

Refunds and Credits

No refunds or credits.

Miscellaneous

BAC members who submit a check that is returned due to insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 charge.
