- Logon to www.DirectAthletics.com and enter the events you want your swimmer(s) to swim.
- Questions can be sent to BACMeetEntry@Bulldogaquaticclub.com
- Write a check made payable to BAC and have your swimmer put the check in the plastic envelope marked Meet Payments (located near the folders on deck) within 10 days of the meet entry deadline to avoid a late fee.
- Relays: BAC will pay for relays for the Long Course Season. All swimmers will be considered for a relay UNLESS you email Greg at gregphill@bulldogaquaticclub.com and let him know your swimmer cannot be on a relay.
- Confirm your entry. An email will be sent out when the psych sheet is available. It is YOUR responsibility to check for accuracy and omissions in meet event #'s and times. All corrections must be done by YOU using the on-line entry system by the stated deadline (in the email announcement).

- Facilities:** The Clarkston High School Natatorium is an indoor 25 SCM, 8 lane pool. The Natatorium has ample spectator area running the entire length of the competition course. Pool depth extends from 14 feet at the start end to 6 feet at the turn end. All lanes are 7.5 feet in width and separated by Competitor lane lines. Permanent starting blocks will be used at the start end. Colorado timing and score board are used. All events will be started at the blocks. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). There is a separate warm down area available for supervised warm-up/warm-down. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
- Eligibility:** The Memorial Open Meet is for those swimmers with “A”, “B”, and “C” times. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States of America Swimming (USA). A swimmer's age on May 22, 2010 will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group.
- Meet Format:** This is an age group swim meet. The swimmers are grouped by age and gender; 10&Under, 11-12, 13-14, and Open. The time standards used in this meet are A, B, and C.
- Swimmers need to be entered into their respective events with a seed time specified for meters course. “No Time” or “NT” entries are strongly discouraged. To calculate conversion times from yards to meters please use the following conversion chart:

| 50y x 1.127 = 50m | 200y x 1.136 = 200m |
| 100y x 1.143 = 100m | 500y x 0.892 = 400m |
- Check In:** Check-In will be available as of 30 minutes prior to the beginning of warm-up session and will close 45 minutes before the beginning of events. Check-In is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from **all** events in that session. Also note that pursuant to MS Rules, failing to swim an event after checking in for that event will disqualify a swimmer from his or her next event. Check-In sheets will be posted in the hallway leading to the locker rooms on the lower level of the Natatorium.

- Scratch Rules:** Prior to Check-In closure, a swimmer may scratch events at the Clerk of Course. After Check-In closes, you must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event. Once a swimmer has checked in for an event, that swimmer must compete in that event or the swimmer will be scratched from his/her next event. No deck check in will be permitted.
- Marshaling:** **This is a self-marshaled meet.** ALL swimmers will be expected to find their heat and lane independently. Heats will not be delayed. Heat sheets will be posted in conspicuous places on deck and be distributed to coaches as soon as possible after Check-In closes. If a swimmer does not show up for the correct heat of the event, that swimmer will be scratched from his/her next scheduled event.
- Seeding:** All events are timed finals. Seeding will be done after Check-In closes. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event, will be scratched from that event. All events will be seeded slowest to fastest. The 400 freestyle will be seeded fastest to slowest with alternating girl and boy heats. We reserve the right to limit the 400 freestyle heats to accommodate the 4 hour rule.
- Meet Programs/
Admissions:** Admission: \$4.00 per person/per day.
Children 10 & Under are free with an adult.
Meet Program: \$6.00 for a 2 day program.
- Awards:** **Medals will be given for places 1-3 in each division.**
Ribbons will be given for places 4-8 in each division.
Awards will be distributed to swimmers. All unclaimed awards will be given to coaches at the end of the meet.
- Concessions:** **Limited.** Concessions will be available at the concessions counter outside the spectator areas, on the upper level of the Natatorium. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.
- Lost and
Found:** Articles may be turned in/picked up near the Clerk Of Course. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).
- Swimming Safety:** Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the meet referee which may include ejection from the meet.
